Report from Secretariat:

We need to move quickly – candidates for these positions must be submitted at the April Secretariat and approved by the community at the May Secuela.

Focus Group reports highlighted our time together. Lisa Pringle shared for the Participation Group. Two outstanding ideas came out regarding Secuelas: Reunion Themes and Food Themes. The group will be organizing a schedule so that members of previous Weekends will lead Secuelas as a team. This will not only share the blessing of serving on the organizing team for a Secuela, but will also bring out more Pescadores and reconnect brothers and sisters in Christ from previous Weekends. Also look for food themes – nothing like ethnic food to reward people for coming out and fellowshiping. ☺ We are also trying to figure out the child care equation. Lastly, a Music Director for the community will be appointed by the President shortly. This person will primarily coordinate Music for Secuelas and Closings. PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE

(To be voted upon at a special secretariat meeting
on April 22 at 7:25pm just prior to the secuela)

Section 2: Term of Office (*Proposed Revision*)

All officers and Chairpersons shall be elected for two year terms, except for the position of Weekend Chairperson, which shall serve for a term of 18 months *and the positions of President and Vice-President. The Vice-President shall serve a term of one year and then automatically succeed to the position of President for a term of one year.*

(The by-law change would change the 2 year term of the Vice President to a one year term as Vice President followed by a one year term as President (the Vice President would automatically succeed to the office of President for the second year of his term).)
