### COMMUNICATIONS!! NEWSLETTER ALERT !!

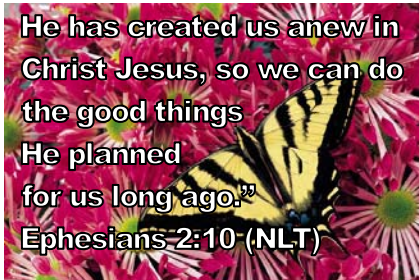
