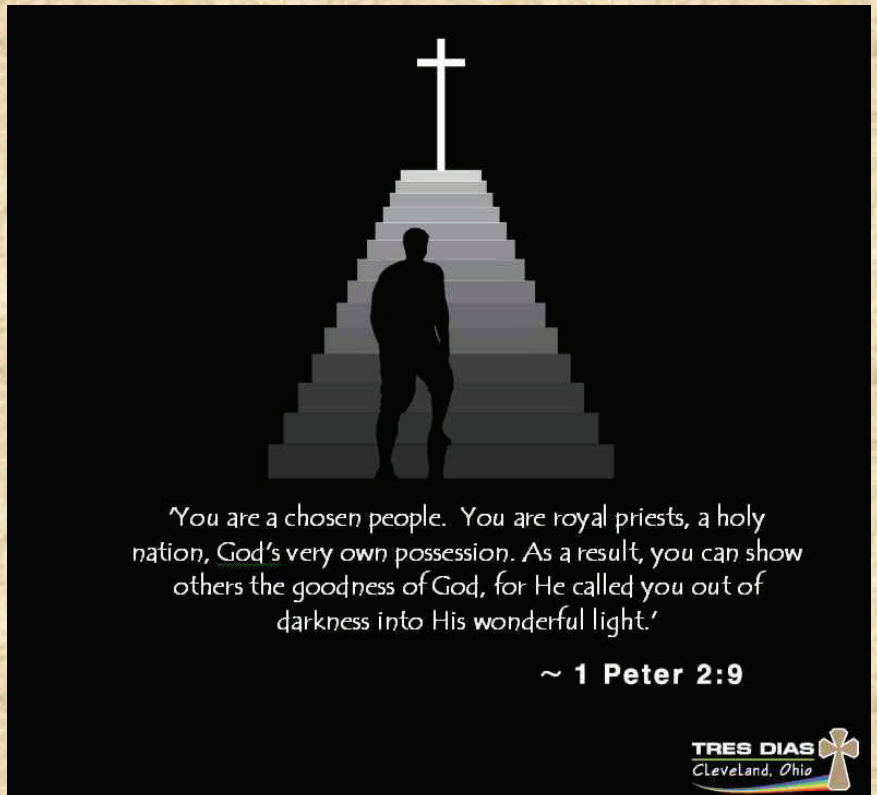

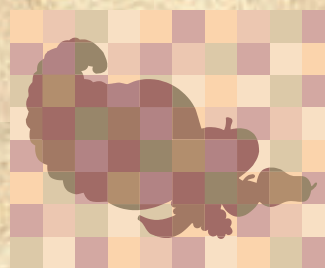
Pay It Forward

The Men's #18 Team will also be commissioned at the September Secuela following the Pay It Forward dinner.

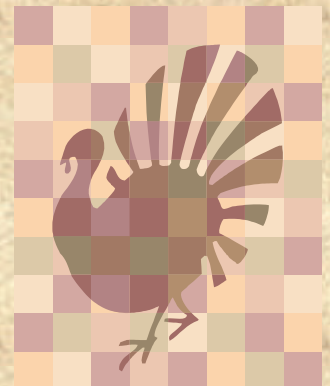
