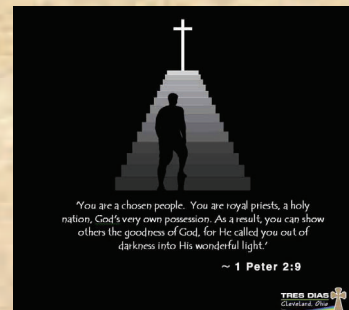

RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO THE SPEAKER:

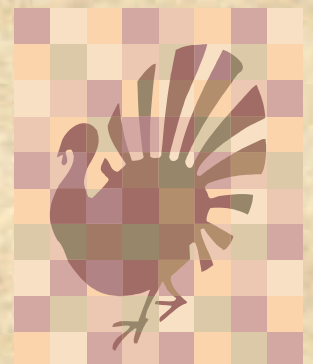
- TD Reunion Group Foldout pamphlet (see questions listed under Piety, Study & Action).
